Six practical learning pathways

Digital Skills for Work, Study & Business	Documents, spreadsheets and presentations.
Computer Basics & Internet Safety	Computer use, files, email and safer online habits.
Excel for Business & Office Administration	Records, budgets and stock spreadsheets.
Job Readiness & Digital Applications	CV preparation and online job applications.
Digital Marketing for Small Businesses	Social content and practical business promotion.
Practical AI for Liberia	Useful AI assistance, fact-checking and privacy.

Existing courses run for three months. Standard published tuition is US\$100 per course. Current class dates, availability, entry requirements and any additional costs must be confirmed. Institutional delivery is quoted in writing.



PILOT CONCEPT & DELIVERY DISCUSSION

Start small. Measure progress.

A proposed 20-learner pilot in digital skills and practical AI for livelihoods.

A proposed first pilot

Start with 20 learners on one suitable course, selected with the partner. Use practical tasks such as office records, shop budgets, job applications and responsible AI use. Confirm trainer assignment, computer access, dates and capacity before agreeing delivery.

ILLUSTRATIVE TUITION BUDGET

20 learners x US\$100 standard tuition

US\$2,000

Tuition only. A planning example, not an institutional quotation or reserved places.

Quote learner support, equipment/data, assessment or certificate charges, materials and reporting separately where needed. Published individual sponsorship offers have their own eligibility and deadlines; group discounts require written confirmation.

Proposed evidence and reporting

Before teaching	Agree objectives and entry skills; use a baseline practical exercise.
During delivery	Track enrolment, attendance, practical work and learner support.
At completion	Assess practical work and completion against agreed criteria.

These are proposed reporting arrangements, not historical results. Share identifiable learner progress only with appropriate permission. Courses do not guarantee employment or an international vendor qualification.

Prepare the programme together

Request registration evidence, trainer details and campus capacity. Agree scope, budget, reporting, payment and cancellation terms in writing.
